### **Description of Lawrence Brothers Memorial Award Fund**

The Lawrence Brothers Memorial Award Fund makes provisions to award an annual \$500 scholarship to a graduating senior at Hillsboro-Deering High School, or a graduate of Hillsboro-Deering High School, who is a resident of Washington, New Hampshire, and who has been accepted at any institution of higher education. NOTE: Qualified Hillsboro-Deering seniors and graduates are equally eligible for the annual scholarship award.

The decision as to which student shall receive the award is made by a Committee composed of the Superintendent of Schools, the Washington School Board and the Senior Class Advisor. Criteria used by the Committee in selecting the recipient of the award include the following:

1. Consideration is first given to any student from Washington who has been accepted for admission at an engineering or technical school; but if no student has been thus accepted, consideration is given to a Washington student who has been accepted at any institution of higher education.
2. If more than one student qualifies, the Committee will consider the following factors in making a final choice:
  - a. Athletic participation in any form;
  - b. Academic achievement; and
  - c. Positive community, school and social attitude.

The entire annual award amount is paid directly to the student selected by the Committee.

If a recipient does not complete one (1) full year of higher education, the recipient is responsible for repaying the full amount of the to the fund (Trustees of Trust Funds, C/O Arline France, 3430 East Washington Road, Washington, NH 03280).
